2023 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Life Kids Club (QuHACKK) is a holiday program for school aged children (years K-6) that is run by Life Anglican Church and held at our Quakers Hill campus. Featuring 4 days of fun-filled events, including our amazing stage-time program (featuring a drama, singing, memory verse challenges and an engaging bible talk). This stage-time program is then followed by 2 hours of activities including: games, craft, cooking and much more. For kids in years 4-6, a special Survivor Challenge will be conducted at a nearby venue, where small groups of students and their leaders experience a range of age-appropriate games and adventures.

Years 4-6 Survivor Challenge

Our year 4-6 will be completing the infamous 'survivor challenge' on an off-site location. Children will be bussed off-site for their programs following the morning stage time, and bussed back in time for the 1pm pick up.

Note: Kindergarten-Year 3 students remain on site for the duration.

FUNDAY SUNDAY

On Sunday following Life Kids Club, we have a celebration event that allows whole families to enjoy and partake in the Life Kids Club experience. There will be stage entertainment, singing, amazing drama AND the premiere screening of our Highlights Video! After the services there is a free BBQ sausage sizzle (water will be provided, and soft drink will be available for sale at \$1 a can), book stall, jumping castles, games and more fun! This is open to the whole family and is most definitely not to be missed!

PAYMENT DETAILS

Full payment is required at the time of registration. This is done within the registration process. After choosing how many tickets you require, the registration details will appear. After all details have been completed, choose 'PayPal' as your payment option (noting it is NOT required for you to have a PayPal account – a credit/debit card will accepted).

WHAT TO BRING

Day 1 – Please bring a water bottle and simple morning tea for each child. On sign up, everyone will then be given their own QuHACKK bag in which to place their belongings (it is ideal if you do not bring an additional bag). Please note that fruit and water will be provided for morning tea each day, however, children are welcome to bring a NUT FREE snack if desired.

QuHACKK is a Nut Aware event. Due to the large number of children attending, we cannot 100% guarantee a completely nut free environment.

Days 2,3,4 – Your QuHACKK bag & water along with your nut free morning tea.

BELONGINGS & ATTIRE

Due to the nature of the activities, we recommend that children wear joggers, comfortable clothes, sunscreen and a hat. Please do not wear expensive clothing or bring any valuables, electronic game consoles, mobile phones, cameras or jewellery. Lost property will be placed in a box at the help desk and we do our best to return items that are clearly labelled. Lost property will be held until the end of the July school holiday period. Please contact the office (02) 9837 2277 to arrange a time to check and collect any lost items.

ELECTRONIC MEDIA/PHOTOS

Please be aware that photographs and videos of the children at Life Kids Club may be taken for the highlights video, Life Anglican Church website, Facebook page and publications in future promotions. Please let us know via email or phone if you require an exemption from this policy.

SICK CHILDREN

No child will be admitted to Life Kids Club if they are showing any signs of illness or infection on arrival, and children are required to wait a minimum of 24 hours before returning to Life Kids Club after being sick. Children will not be permitted to attend and adults are not permitted on site if they are showing any signs or symptoms of Covid-19 including cough, sore throat, runny nose and fever.

If you are unsure whether your child may attend, please call the office (02) 9837 2277 after 8:30am on the day in question to discuss.

Parents/carers are ultimately responsible for determining their child's ability to actively participate in the daily activities. While we sympathise with the needs of each parent, we must provide a healthy environment for other children and leaders. If a child becomes ill during the Life Kids Club program, parents will be contacted to collect their child. In the event of an accident, first aid will be administered and an ambulance will be called if necessary. Should transportation to hospital be required a Life Kids Club leader will travel with your child until such time as their parent can take over.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

Regular medication, Epipens, asthma puffers, antibiotics, and any other medication that may be required during Kids Club will need to be signed in and out each day with the First Aid Officer. All known medical conditions need to be disclosed during the registration process. Should your child suffer from either asthma or anaphylaxis, a current Medical Action Plan **MUST** be provided by email to admin@lifeac.org.au

ADDITIONAL SUPPORT

We recognise that the needs of individual children vary and we will endeavour to accommodate children with additional needs within the Life Kids Club program. We are realistic about the limitations of our environment for children with additional needs and attendance is considered on an individual basis and is determined by our staffing ratio and experience to ensure appropriate care is offered for all children attending. We expect parents to inform us of any potential behaviour issues that would help us to deal with situations in a positive manner. Please contact the committee (office@lifeac.org.au) prior to booking to discuss any requirements further and to consider what (if any) arrangements can and need to be put in place.

BEHAVIOUR EXPECTATIONS

We set ourselves high standards and expect that the children attending Life Kids Club behave in accordance: treating others, personal property and facilities with respect; listening to and following instructions all leaders and positive participation in activities. Swearing, abusive language, aggressive behaviour or violence will not be tolerated. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in parents being asked to collect and sign out their child immediately.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE ARRANGEMENTS

Please respect our Life Kids Club times by delivering and collecting your child(ren) in line with the published times. Your child must be picked up within 15 minutes of the conclusion. We cannot guarantee staffing levels beyond this finish time. Children must be signed out by an authorised adult as listed in the registration form. We will not allow any child to return home unaccompanied or with an unauthorised adult.

QUALITY AND SAFETY

Our Life Kids Club continues to operate with an exemplary health and safety record. All leaders participate in a comprehensive training program before Life Kids Club that includes: Child Protection Training, Safe Ministry Check, Working with Children Check, Allergy Awareness, First Aid Procedures, Fire and Evacuation Procedures and Equipment Safety. Leaders are appointed following the Committee's selection process.
